

NETBALL SA BOARD MEMBER NOMINATION INFORMATION

Applications are sought from suitably qualified individuals who wish to be considered for election to the Board of the South Australian Netball Association Inc, trading as Netball SA.

Three Board positions are available and successful applicants will be elected for a two year term. The election of Board members will take place at the December meeting of the Netball SA Council with the elected Board members appointed to two year terms commencing at the end of the Netball SA Annual General meeting to be held on Thursday 7 February 2019.

OUR ORGANISATION

Netball SA is the peak body for netball in South Australia, is a member of Netball Australia and has the following primary key responsibilities:

- To govern over netball in South Australia
- To provide strategic direction for the sport in South Australia
- To provide performance pathways, programs, services and competitions for players, coaches, officials and administrators
- To provide education and training to assist the development of coaches, officials and administrators
- To drive and support the growth of the sport from the grassroots community level through to the elite level
- To continue to grow the profile of netball

Netball SA is a not-profit state sporting organisation established to support and promote the sport of netball in South Australia through the marketing, organisation and facilitation of all aspects of the game at local, state and national levels.

COUNCIL

The membership is represented at Council meetings by Delegates who represent our member Associations, Divisions, coaches and umpires. Council meetings are held four times a year usually on the first Thursday in April, June, August and December.

BOARD

The Board is currently made up of nine (9) members; including the President, seven (7) general Board members appointed by Council and one (1) Board appointed director. The Board manages the affairs of Netball SA and appoints the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).

REQUIREMENTS / OBLIGATIONS

1. Board members are expected to meet at least once a month for Board meetings.
2. Board members are expected to also participate in sub-committees or working groups as determined from time to time by the Board.
3. Board members must be prepared for meetings by reviewing papers / reports, financial documents and becoming familiar with sport / business trends and netball news.
4. It is highly desirable there is Board presence at Council meetings. A roster is prepared for this purpose to ensure coverage.

The Board has primary responsibility to members for the sustainability and relevance of Netball SA by guiding and monitoring its business and affairs. In carrying out its responsibilities, the Board undertakes to serve the interests of Netball SA members, employees, customers and the broader community.

NOMINATIONS

Netball SA has a commitment to securing and maintaining a balanced and skilled Board to represent its members and their interests. Netball SA also has a commitment to provide contemporary, respected corporate governance and leadership to the membership. Experience in the areas of business, legal affairs, communications, commercial and marketing, government relations and finance, in addition to an understanding of sport, will be highly regarded.
